Meditation

Trinity Sunday, Year C

Proverbs 8:22-31, Psalm 8:4-9, Romans 5:1-5, John 16:12-15

I have much more to tell you.

John 16:12

Had Jesus run out of time?

Why didn't he tell his disciples everything he had in mind?

Had the Last Supper taken too long?

No, Jesus' timing was always perfect. He knew his hour had come—it hadn't snuck up on him. And he was always ready for whatever he had to do. Rather, Jesus had "much more" to teach his disciples because they weren't ready to hear it. They couldn't understand everything yet. They needed time and experience—and a lot of help from the Holy Spirit.

Like those disciples, we have much more to learn. We don't quite comprehend a lot of what Jesus teaches, and we need the Spirit's help to live out the things that we do understand. Take today's feast of the Holy Trinity as a classic example. Every Sunday we proclaim that we believe in one God in three divine Persons: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. But the Trinity is a mystery we will never fully comprehend. Jesus certainly has a lot he can teach us—about the Trinity and so much more.
