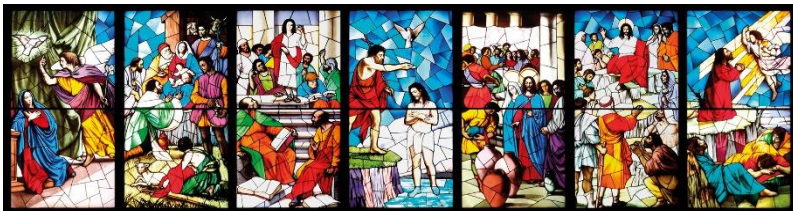

SUNDAY BIBLE REFLECTION

7th Sunday of Easter, Year C

Acts 7:55-60, Psalm 96(97):1-2b,6-7,9, Revelation 22:12-14,16-17,20, John 17:20-26

Jesus prays to God the Father about matters that are central to the life of a disciple and the life of the Church. One of these matters is unity: man's unity with God, and the unity of human persons with each other.

The greatest threat to unity with God and our neighbors is sin. Our sins pierce our souls as they pierced the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Because of this, our souls can become like sieves, unable to contain the grace of the Holy Spirit's Presence and His seven gifts. So our Christian life poses to us the struggle of allowing our souls to be re-created. This means first being washed clean of sin in Baptism and being renewed in our relationship with God through the Sacrament of Confession.

Some people claim that believing in the Sacrament of Confession cheapens the meaning of our Christian faith. They claim that being able to go to Confession repeatedly encourages people to sin. Of course, this makes about as much sense as saying that being able to take a shower every day encourages people to get dirty and stink. God gave us the Sacrament of Confession because he knows that without Him, we can do nothing.
