Sunday Meditation

Jesus knew his hour had come. Judas was about to betray him, and that would usher in the events of his passion and death. In those final moments, Jesus prayed to his Father—not just for his disciples, but for the entire Church. Each person who would come to believe in him was on his mind and in his heart, including you. You are part of

Jesus' great prayer!

Christ. That means he prayed that you would desire and work for unity. That also means that he prayed that you would come to participate more fully in the unity that Jesus has with his Father.

loved them even as you loved me (John 17:23). Jesus prayed that you would show the people around you what it looks like to be a beloved child of God. Your life becomes a clear witness to this love in the way that you are united with other believers. Or in the way that you love your neighbor. Or in the way that you live in the dignity of being a cherished son or daughter of God.

They are your gift to me (John 17:24). Jesus sees you as a gift. He looked forward to the day you would be born. He anticipated all the ways he would work in your life and draw you to faith. You are precious to him. The same goes for all your brothers and sisters in
